“Fratelli Tutti”

“Fratelli Tutti” is the message of Jesus encouraging us to recognize one another as brothers and sisters and to live accordingly in the common home that the Father entrusted to us” (Pope Francis, 01 Oct 2020). “Fratelli Tutti,” as with *Laudato Si’*, is an Italian quotation from Saint Francis of Assisi, which is translated as “brothers [& sisters] all” (*Admonitions*, 6, 1), “that shows his openness of heart, which knew no bounds and transcended differences of origin, nationality, colour or religion” (FT, 3).



The 287-paragraph Encyclical is a summary statement of Pope Francis’ social teaching, in which the Holy Father reminds us, especially in the backdrop of social distancing caused by the pandemic Covid-19, that we ought to love our brothers and sisters as much as we would love them, when they are with us.

The Encyclical “Fratelli Tutti” aims at promoting a universal aspiration toward fraternity and social friendship. Beginning with our common membership in the human family, from the conviction that we are brothers and sisters as we are the children of one Creator, we need to realize that in a globalized and interconnected world, only together we can be saved. As Martin Luther King Jr puts it, “We must learn to live together as brothers or perish together as fools.”
