Sebastian Athappilly, CMI has been a teacher of systematic theology from 1985 and Professor from 1998 at DVK, Bangalore. He served also as the President of DVK, Registrar and the Dean of the faculty of theology. He has attended the Synod for Asia as theological expert. He was a member of the Office of Theological Concerns (OTC) of the FABC for 5 years. He served the CMI Congregation as the Provincial of Thrissur Devamatha Province, Procurator General and Postulator General in Rome, Master of scholastics and spiritual director in Dharmaram College. He had his higher studies in philosophy and theology in Pune (JDV), Graz (Austria) and under Karl Lehmann in Freiburg i. Br. (Germany). He has studied also in Sankt Georgen (Frankfurt), Tübingen and Steubenville (Ohio). His doctoral dissertation was on the theology of Karl Rahner and published under the title Glaube und Welt in 1987.

He has taught also in the theological institutes like St Peter's Seminary, Kristu Jyothi College, and CRI Brothers' Institute in Bangalore, St Thomas' Apostolic Seminary and MOC in Vadavathoor, Kottayam. He has written several books and articles in English and German and presented papers at different theological seminars and colloquiums. Presently he is working as hospital chaplain in a Unive sity Clinic in Austria and as guest professor at DVK.
